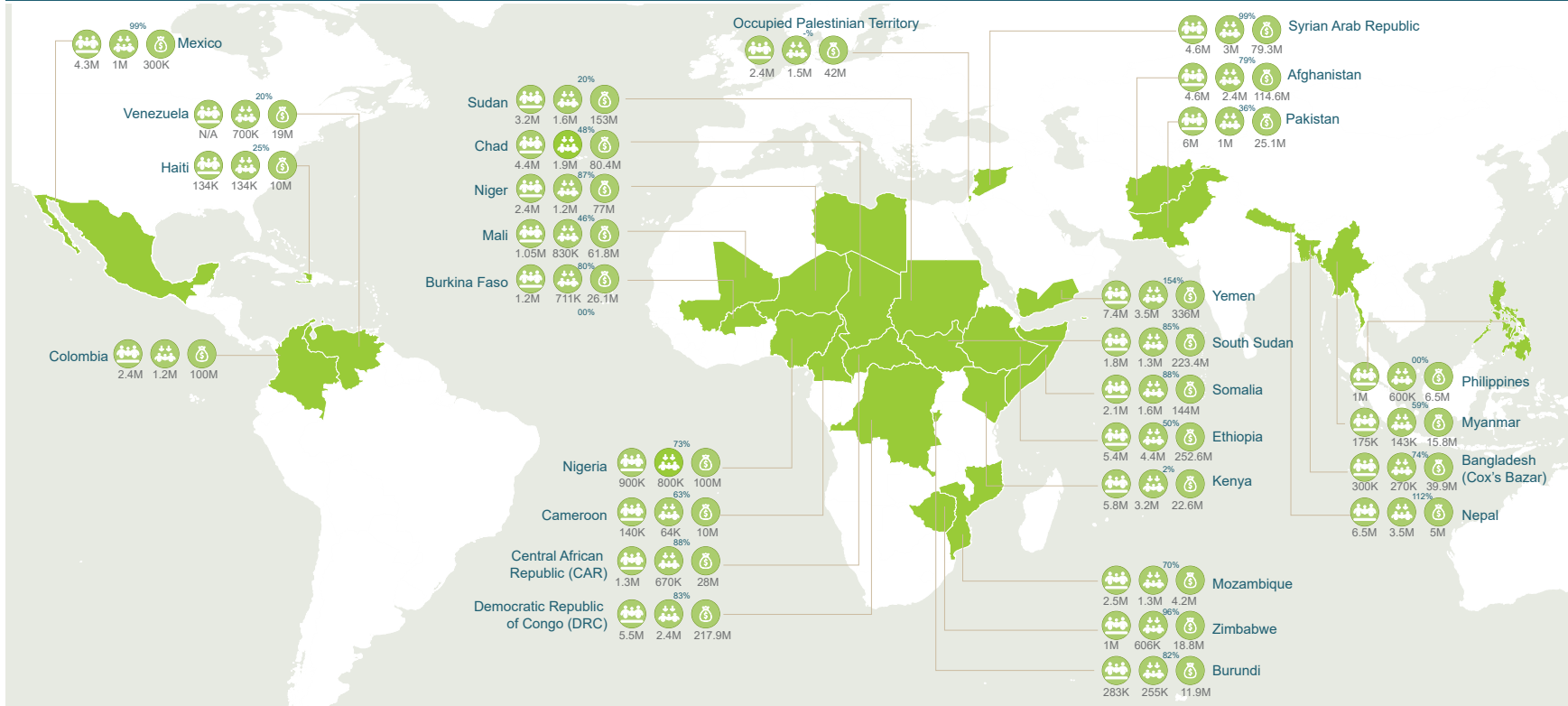
# GNC COUNTRY REPORT 2020

The Global Nutrition Cluster (GNC) supported a coordinated response in 29 countries in Africa, Asia and South America in 2020, for nutrition coordination mechanisms to ensure a timely and effective response to the emergency nutrition needs of children and women. In 2020, 77.8 million people including children aged under five years old and pregnant and lactating women were identified as being in need of life-saving nutrition assistance across the 29 countries; country cluster/sector coordination mechanisms targeted about 42 million out of the total people in need of nutrition in emergencies.

A total of 29 million children and women were reached through emergency nutrition response services in 2020. This represents about 69 per cent of the response plan targets.

Thirteen countries (Afghanistan, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Democratic Republic of Congo, Mexico, Nepal, Niger, Somalia, South Sudan, Syrian Arab Republic, Yemen and Zimbabwe) achieved more than 75 per cent of the annual Humanitarian Response Plan (HRP) target, while nine countries (Bangladesh - Cox's Bazar, Central African Republic, Kenya, Mexico, Myanmar, Nepal, Nigeria, Occupied Palestinian Territory and South Sudan) received more than 50 per cent of funding requirements. Six countries (Chad, Kenya, Mali, Pakistan, Sudan and Venezuela) achieved below 50 per cent of their annual targets.

Approximately 775 million USD (35 per cent) in funding out of 2.2 billion USD funding requested was received by the end of 2020.
