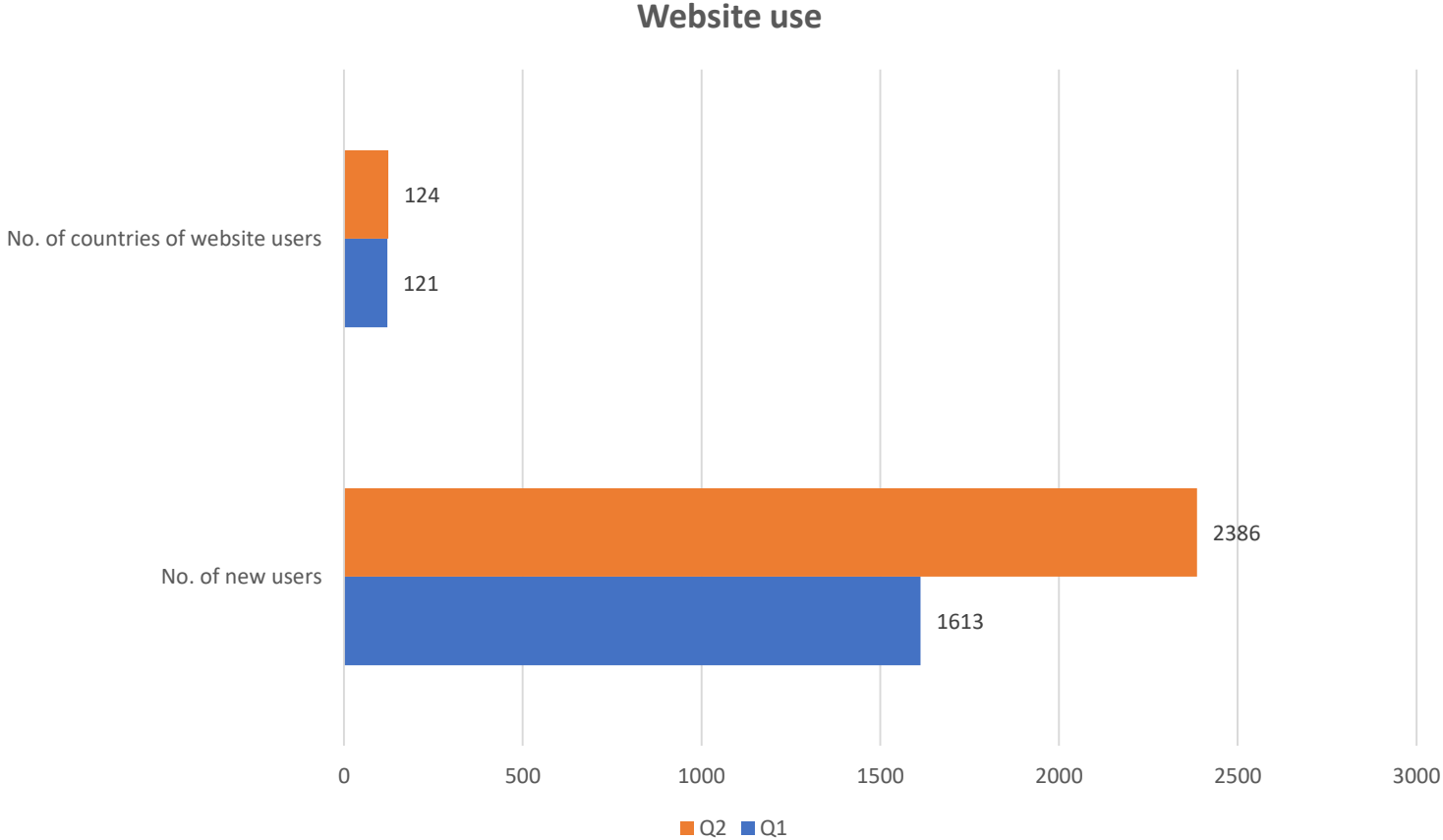

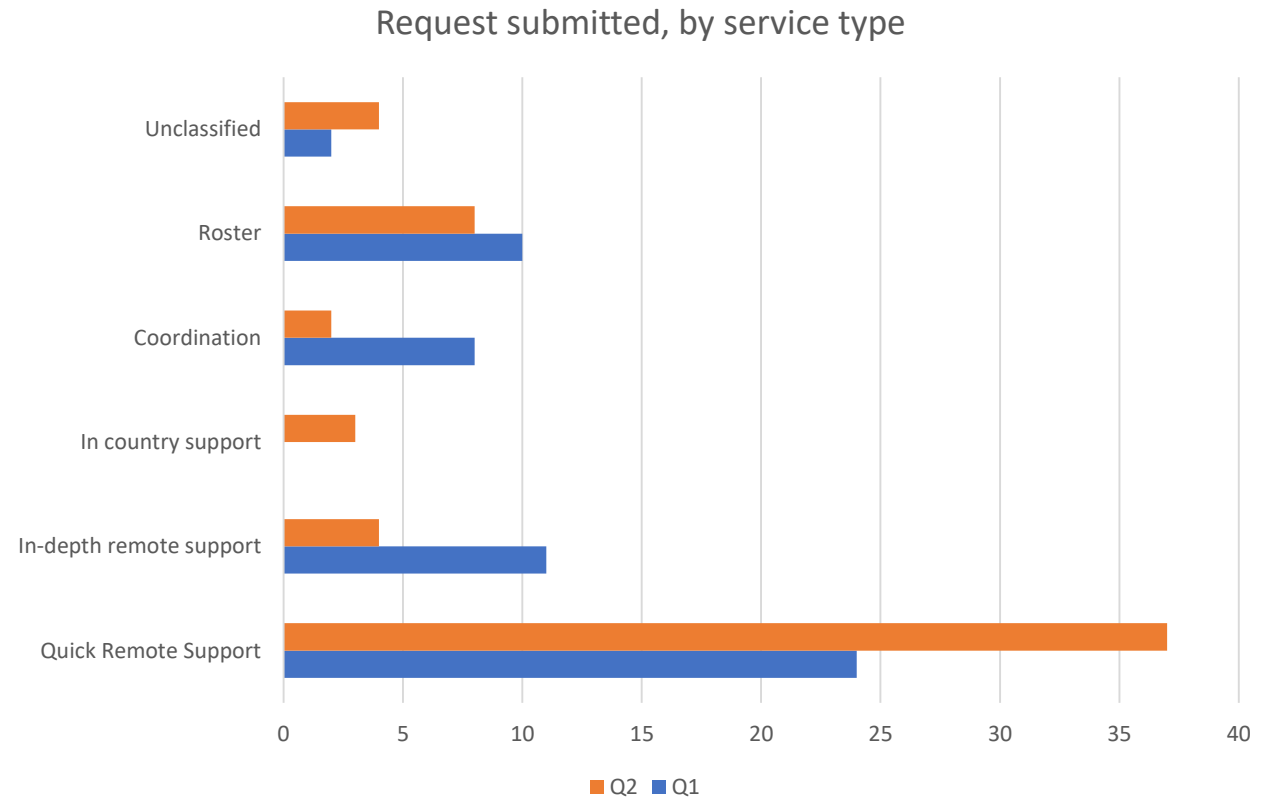
Accessing resources & services

- 48% increase in new website users



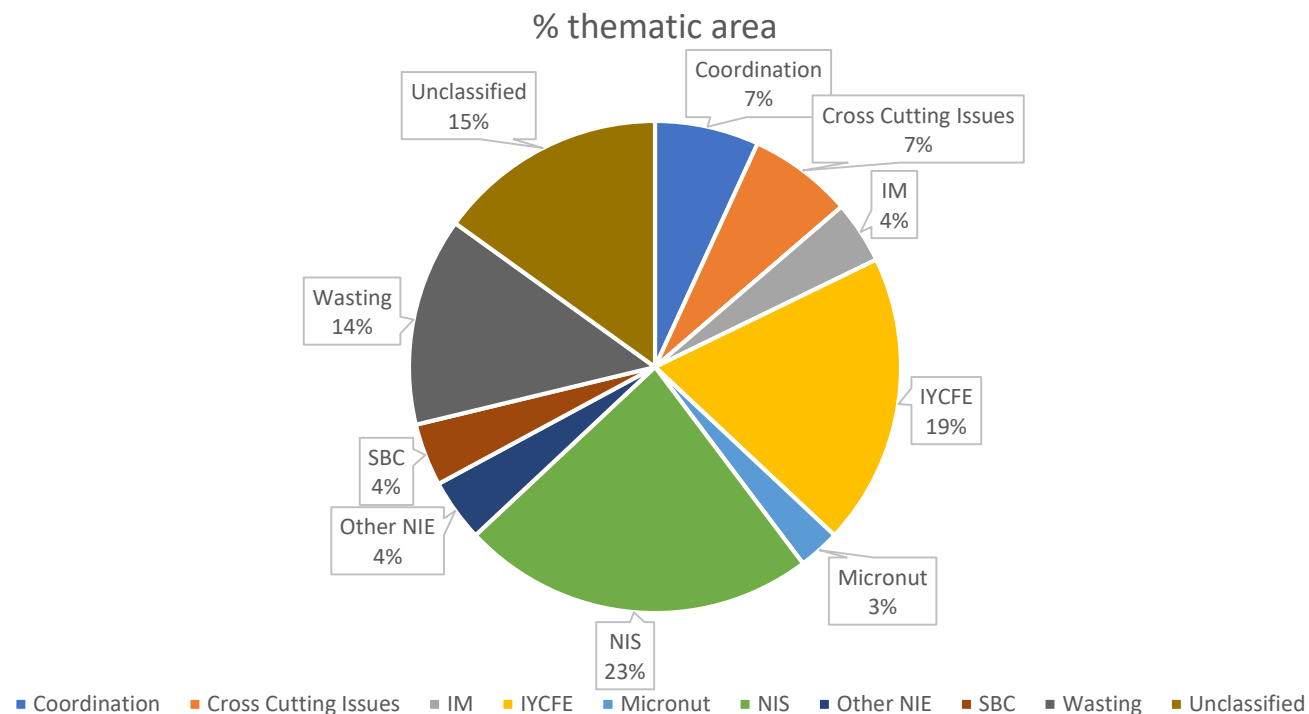
Requests for Support

- **58 requests** for support submitted
 - 37-Quick Remote Technical Support
 - 4-In-depth Remote Support
 - 3-In-country Support
 - 2-Coordination and IM
 - 8-Roster
 - 4-Unclassified
- **5% increase** requests over Q1



Of the 58 requests submitted for Q2, they were tagged as:

- Coordination = 4
- Cross cutting themes = 5
- Information management = 3
- IYCFE = 14
- Micronutrients = 2
- NIS = 17
- Other NIE = 3
- Social Behaviour Change = 3
- Wasting = 10
- No classification = 11

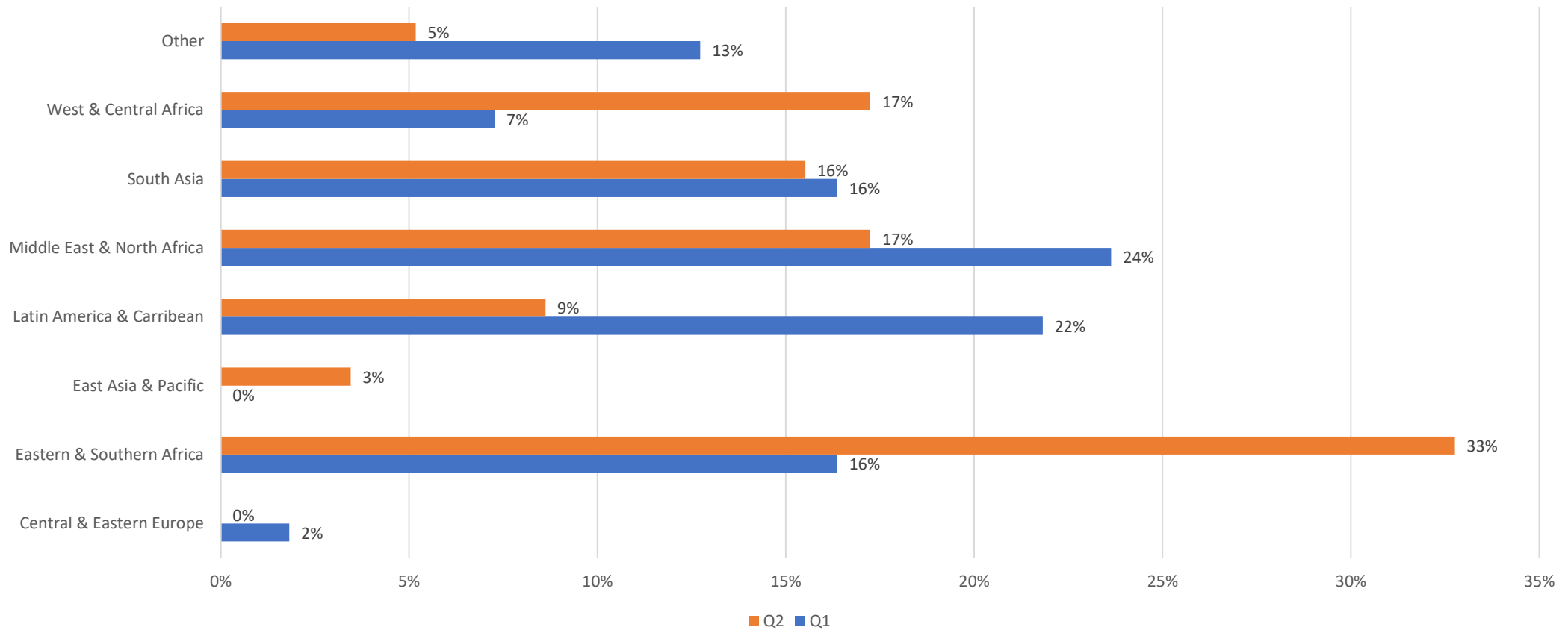

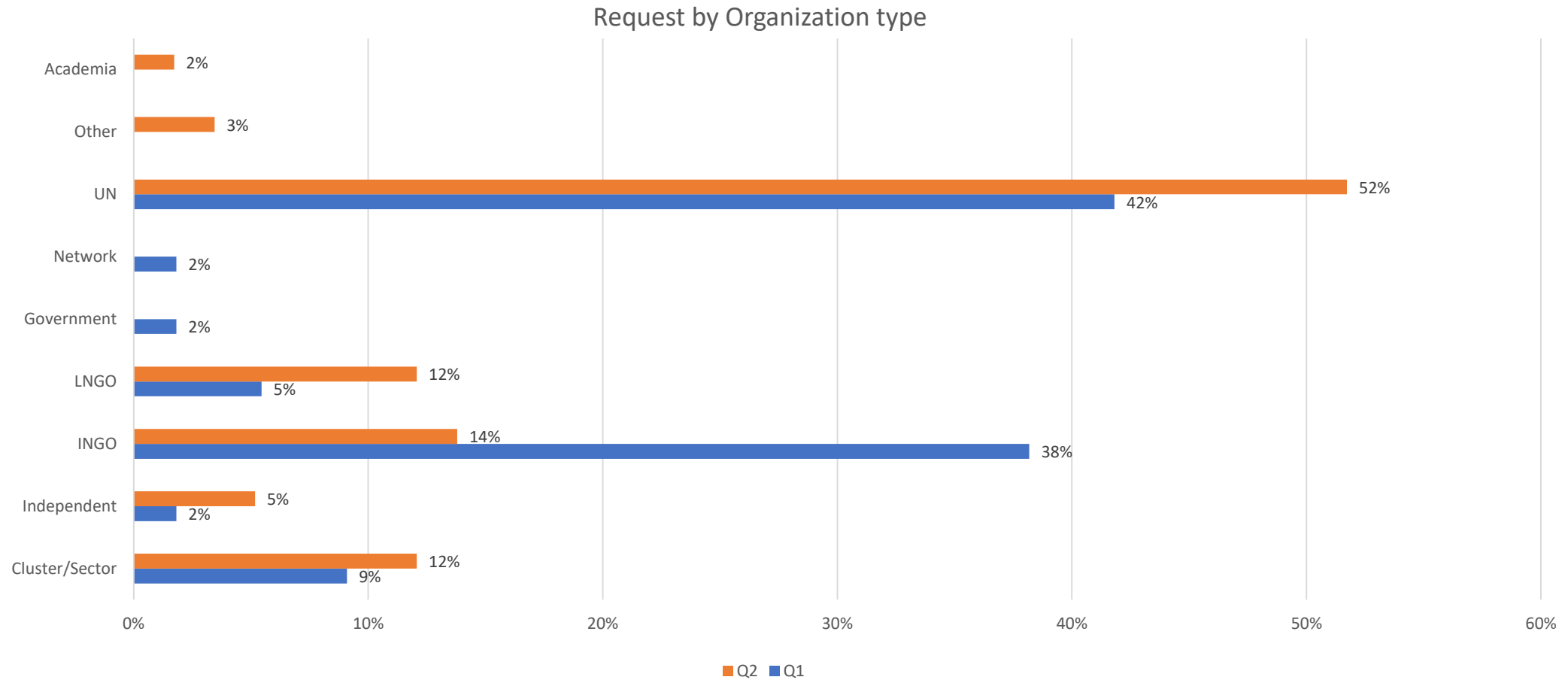
Where are requests for support coming from?

GNC Annual Meeting

- [GNC Satellite event](#) provided an update on the activities of the Alliance since December 2020, including a Q&A panel with the Leadership Team.
- The Alliance Leadership Team also contributed to satellite events on [Capacity Building](#) and [COVID-19 Learning](#).

Learning Needs & Products

- 4 technical needs were identified during this quarter: Using MUAC and/or anthropometric classification, Supervision checklists for IYCFE & CMAM, IYCF Capacity Assessment for organizations, and Micronutrients & Specialized Nutrition Products.
- Work continues on learning regarding local NGOs using the Alliance to support their technical capacity gaps and needs.

Thought Leadership Updates

- Three GTWGs held satellite events as part of the GNC Annual Meeting ([CVA](#), [IFE](#), [NIS](#)). These working sessions oriented the broader GNC membership to the work of the GTWGs and explored gaps in the respective thematic areas.
- The process for groups obtaining funding for work related to identified technical gaps was initiated during the quarter with a ‘Funding Principles and Process’ document developed by the GNC Alliance Leadership Team.
- A second cross-chair quarterly call was set up to explore areas of collaboration across the GTWGs and processes for identifying technical gaps.
