



Global Nutrition Cluster | Summary of country-level achievements for NiE coordination mechanisms (January - June 2021)





OVERVIEW OF COUNTRY-LEVEL TRENDS



- ★ Total of 34 countries reported on cluster/sector coordination for January-June 2021
- ★ 71.6 M identified as people in need (PIN) of nutrition interventions in 2021 (increase of 10 M from Mid-year report, 2020)
- ★ 46% of people targeted (19 M of 40.8 M) reached through NiE response by mid-2021
- ★ 23% funding received (599M USD) of amount requested (2,625M USD) 7% less than Mid-year report, 2020

CHALLENGES AT COUNTRY LEVEL

- ★ Ongoing COVID-19 infections affecting service providers & delivery of nutrition services
- ★ Impact of COVID-19 global financial crisis on funding for humanitarian response: significant gaps between need & coverage with low funding of HRPs
- ★ Increases in programming costs due to deteriorating economic situation (inflation/currency devaluation)
- ★ Persistent conflict/insecurity restricting movement of people and nutrition supplies
- Rise in displaced populations with associated vulnerability to malnutrition
- ★ Issues in gathering & reporting nutrition data
- ★ Limited/stretched human resources for nutrition at national & sub-national level
