# PURPOSE OF MINIMUM PACKAGE

- Guideline & reference document for all nutrition program personnel and partners supporting nutrition services
- To facilitate optimal service provision through Health Facilities, IDP camps and outreach sites in the communities



# PROCESS TO DATE

- **Nutrition Package**

- Shared & inputs incorporated (*WFP, IRC, MDM, MSF-F, UNICEF, ACF,*)

- **IYCF-E Workshops in Borno & Yobe ( 1 day)**

To review, refine and improve the proposed IYCF-E minimum package of services

- **Borno:** State (*SNO, Data Manager and State Nutrition staff*)  
20/27 LGAs, 4 partners (*SCI, ACF, UNICEF, IRC*)
- **Yobe:** State, 17/17 LGAs, 4 partners (*WFP, ACF, UNICEF, COOPI*)

**Goal: To contribute to a reduction in morbidity, mortality and malnutrition amongst children 0 – 59 months affected by the crisis in North Eastern Nigeria.**
