

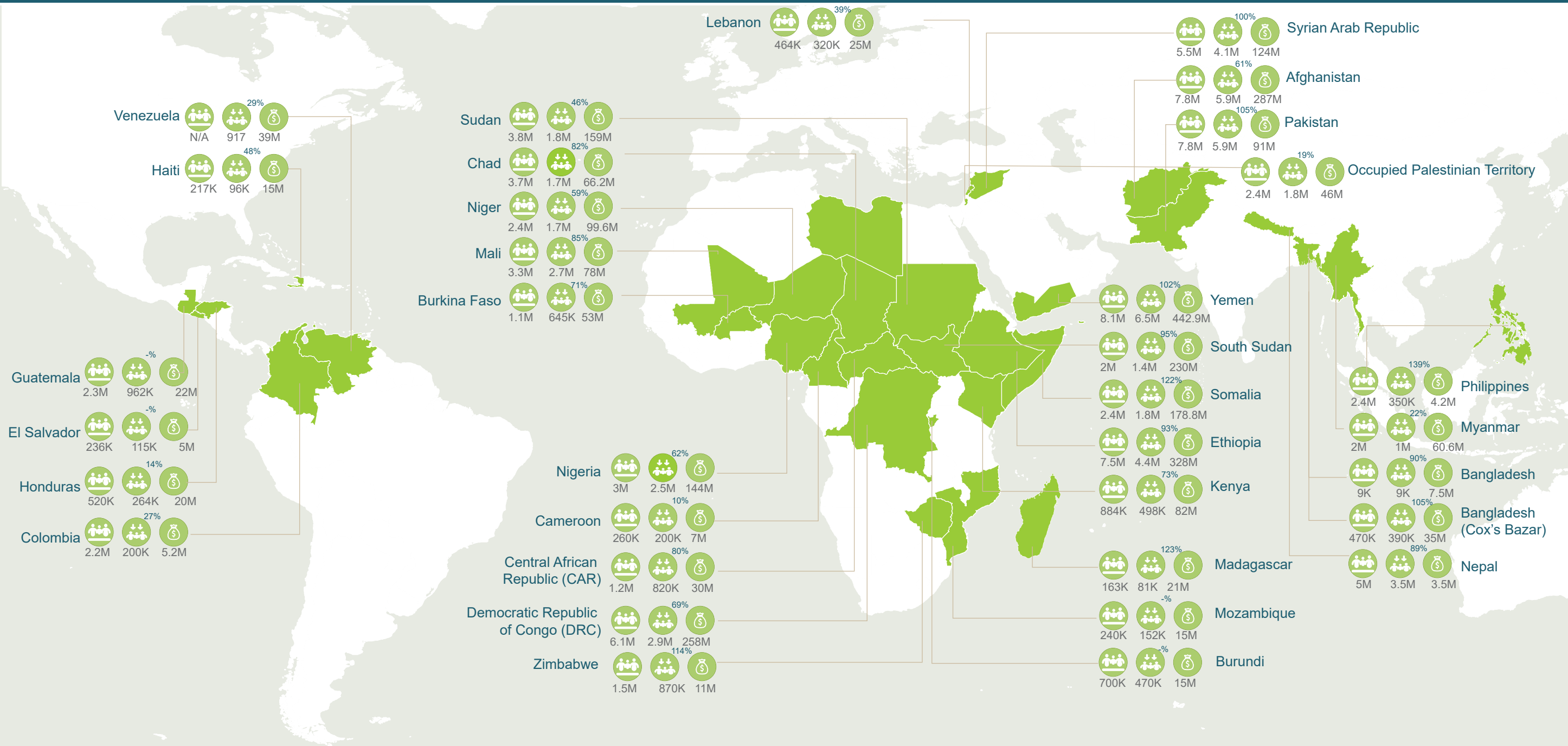

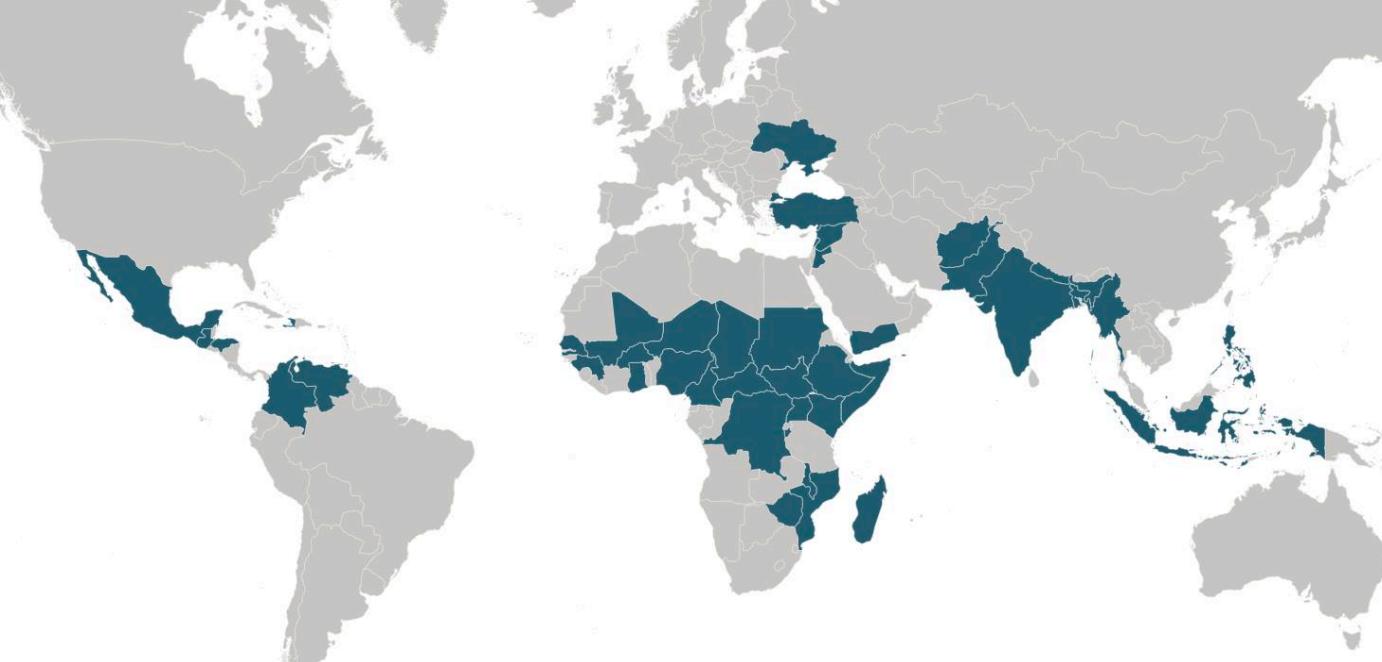

COUNTRY SUMMARY

The GNC supported a coordinated response in 33 countries in Africa, Asia and South America assuring a timely and effective response to nutrition in emergencies (NiE). Of these countries, 20 (Afghanistan, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Democratic Republic of Congo, Ethiopia, Lebanon, Madagascar, Mali, Mozambique, Myanmar, Niger, Nigeria, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan, Venezuela, Whole of Syria, and Yemen) had an activated nutrition cluster, 10 countries (Bangladesh, Burundi, Cox's Bazar, Guatemala, Haiti, Kenya, Nepal, Pakistan, Philippines, and Zimbabwe) had a national nutrition sector coordination mechanisms, and three (Colombia, Honduras, and occupied Palestinian territory) had other coordination mechanisms in place.

In 2022, 89 million people were identified as people in need of nutrition interventions. In the above countries, the estimates for people in need (PiN) increased by 15.7 million compared to 2021 (73.3 million PiN), similarly the number of people targeted increased by about 12 million, totalling 56 million people targeted in 2022. Of those targeted, the GNC was able to reach 77% (43 million) with the necessary support, including a total of 43.9 million children and women reached through emergency nutrition response services in 2022.

About 1.5 billion USD (50%) of funding was received by nutrition partners out of 3 billion USD requested for 2022. By the end of 2022, 13 countries (Burundi, Cameroon, Colombia, El Salvador, Guatemala, Haiti, Honduras, Lebanon, Mozambique, Myanmar, occupied Palestine territory, Sudan, Venezuela) received less than 50 percent of the funding requested.
