WHAT IS THE AAP WORKING GROUP?

- The Group is a vital part of the Global Nutrition Cluster (GNC), championing accountability and inclusion in alignment with the IASC strategic priorities for 2024-2025.
- It is dedicated to providing accountability in humanitarian crises, prioritizing those furthest behind, and systematically incorporating feedback from affected communities.
- The AAP Working Group aims to ensure a community-centered and effective response to nutrition in emergencies.

PURPOSE AND ACTIVITIES

1. Enhance capacities of the GNC members on AAP for Nutrition in Emergencies (NiE) to incorporate AAP principles and actions in the coordination and technical support to NiE practitioners.
2. Increase availability of technical support, resources and capacity to integrate AAP within NiE programs for practitioners.
3. Expand the AAP agenda within the NiE sector to increase focus on AAP within planning, implementation and evaluation of nutrition programs.
